PRICE

Prices are subject to alteration without notice, goods are offered subject to availability and shall be charged to your account at the prices ruling at the date of transaction.

PAYMENT

Unless otherwise agreed in writing, your account will be due for settlement 25 days from the date of the monthly statement without deduction.

All vouchers and discounts are to be presented at the point of transaction. SCATS Countrystores plc cannot accept these against payment of account retrospectively.

Payment on account can only be made by cheque, debit card or BACS deposit. SCATS Countrystores plc cannot accept credit card payment to settle account balances. SCATS Countrystores plc do not sell by any "sale or return" basis.

If settlement is not made in full, and you have not advised our offices of any statement queries before the due date, SCATS Countrystores plc reserve the right to charge interest at a rate of 24% per annum or 2% per month on your account. In addition SCATS Countrystores plc reserve the right to withdraw credit facilities, to call for payment of all goods and services supplied at any time and to request payment with order on delivery even though a contract for the supply of goods may exist.

The SCATS Countrystores Account may only be used by authorised signatories as specified in the application form and the SCATS Countrystores Account Amendment to Signatories Form.

The account holder is responsible for settlement of the account, whether purchases were made by the account holder or an additional card holder.

The SCATS Countrystores store manager reserves the right to charge the account without the customer providing the relevant, current SCATS Countrystores Account Card.

Any SCATS Countrystores Account Card issued for us on the SCATS Countrystores account remains the property of SCATS Countrystores plc, who reserve the right to withdraw it at any time.

GOODS LOST/ DAMAGED IN TRANSIT (DELIVERIES)

No liability for damage, loss of content or short delivery will be considered unless notified to the sending SCATS Countrystore, within three days of the delivery of the goods. Telephone notification must be followed in writing. Signatures endorsed "unexamined" or "unchecked" have no legal significance and will not be accepted by SCATS Countrystores plc or the carriers as a basis of claim. Where outside carriers are used, it is essential that the carrying company is also notified as to damage, loss or short delivery in accordance with the provisions of this clause. Notification must be made to SCATS Countrystores plc for non-delivery of goods within ten days of the date of invoice.

BASIS OF SALE

SCATS Countrystores plc reserve the right to seek credit references.

TITLE AND OWNERSHIP

- a). The risk in the goods shall pass to the buyer upon point of sale and the buyer shall insure them against loss or damage by the usual commercial risk.
- b). Ownership in the goods supplied shall remain with SCATS Countrystores plc until the buyer has paid in full the price of the goods and/ or services supplied by SCATS Countrystores plc to the buyer.
- c). In the event of SCATS Countrystores plc exercising their rights under clause g) hereof and repossessing goods, for which the buyer has paid SCATS Countrystores plc shall be entitled to set off against any sums which become due to the buyer as a result of repossession of the goods any sums from the buyer in respect of other goods supplied.
- d). The buyer shall store the goods so as to make them readily identifiable as the goods belonging to SCATS Countrystores plc.
- e). The buyer shall hold the proceeds of sale of unpaid goods as agents for SCATS Countrystores plc and shall ensure that they remain identifiable as such.
- f). The buyer's right to possession of the goods shall cease if:
 - i. The buyer fails to make payments in accordance with these terms, or such other terms as may from time to time be agreed, or
 - ii. The buyer is declared bankrupt or makes any proposal to its creditors for a composition or other voluntary arrangement, or
 - iii. A Receiver, Liquidator or Administrator is appointed in respect of the buyer's business, or
 - iv. SCATS Countrystores plc believes by reason of the conduct of the buyer that there is a risk that the buyer will be unable to make payment for any goods which have been supplied by SCATS Countrystores plc to the buyer as and when payments for those goods fall due.
- g). Upon the cessation of the buyer's right to possession of the goods in accordance with clause f) hereof:
 - i. The buyer shall at their own expense make the goods available to SCATS Countrystores plc and allow SCATS Countrystores plc to repossess them.
 - ii. The buyer hereby grants SCATS Countrystores plc, their servants and agents an irrevocable licence to enter with or without vehicles any premise where the goods are stored in order to repossess them and inspect them at any time.
 - iii. The buyer shall identify all goods supplied by SCATS Countrystores plc and provide them with every facility and co-operate fully with their identification and removal.
